On Sunday morning it was raining too, but in the afternoon it cleared off a little mother, & daddy & I & Joan went for a walk down to the sea, and the wind was so strong that it blew me and Joan right over and pretty nearly blew mother over, and as we where walking along we saw a little tug-boat not very far out, and the waves were about 5 or 6 feet high, and the little was tossed about like anything, and to us it looked as iff its ~~was bobbing~~ decks where going under the water and when it came up its bows where out of the water, and ~~when~~ then I came back to the school, and played a game of cards with another boy.
