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How can educators use the Royal BC Museum Learning Portal?

This inquiry is important to me because I value the connected learning opportunities presented by digital platforms, and I wanted to share this with my colleagues. This aligns with my philosophy of maximizing accessibility in education: I want to help people feel comfortable about starting to use this tool, and I want the resources to be accessible to people who might not have the means to go to the museum in person.

The Learning Portal also provides opportunities to model inquiry, and to share multimodal resources. These are immensely valuable opportunities for Social Studies, and beyond. Through this inquiry project, I increased my familiarity with the Learning Portal and the processes of adding, editing, and sharing content.

Creating this online resource, and sharing it on Twitter, has allowed me to spread this idea beyond my cohort community. The museum and educators from across BC have shared this page with their networks. I have increased my connection to the Royal BC Museum, and taken a step towards the kind of multi-access and multimodal education that I want to facilitate.
