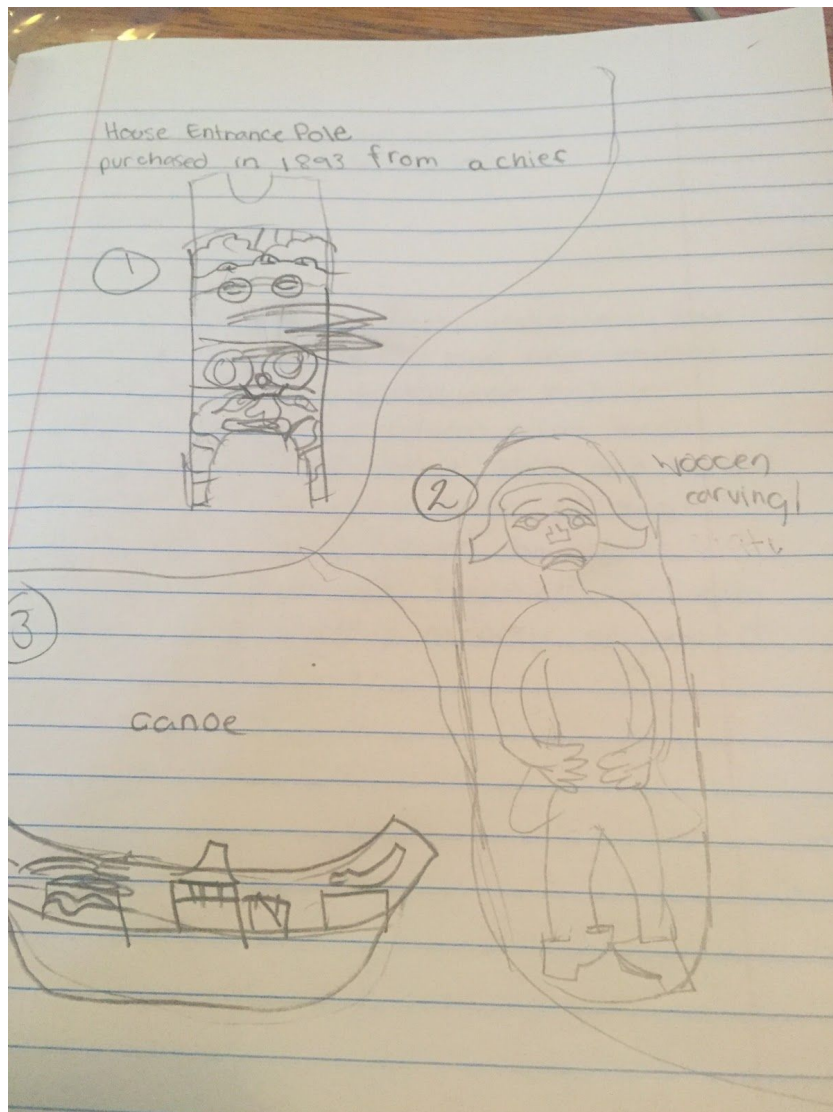
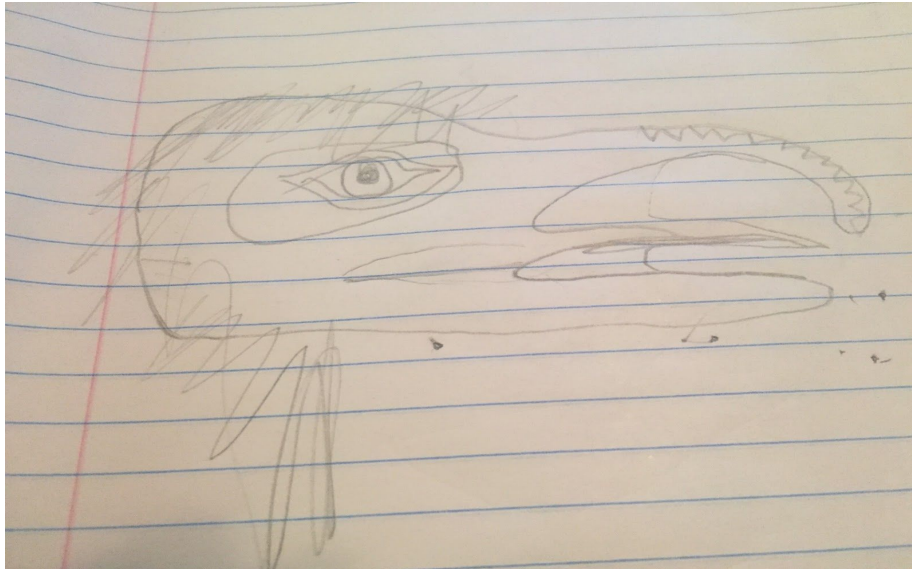


RBCM Visit

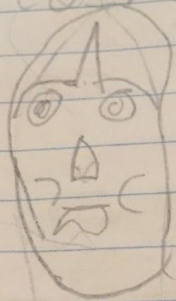
