

# Current events project

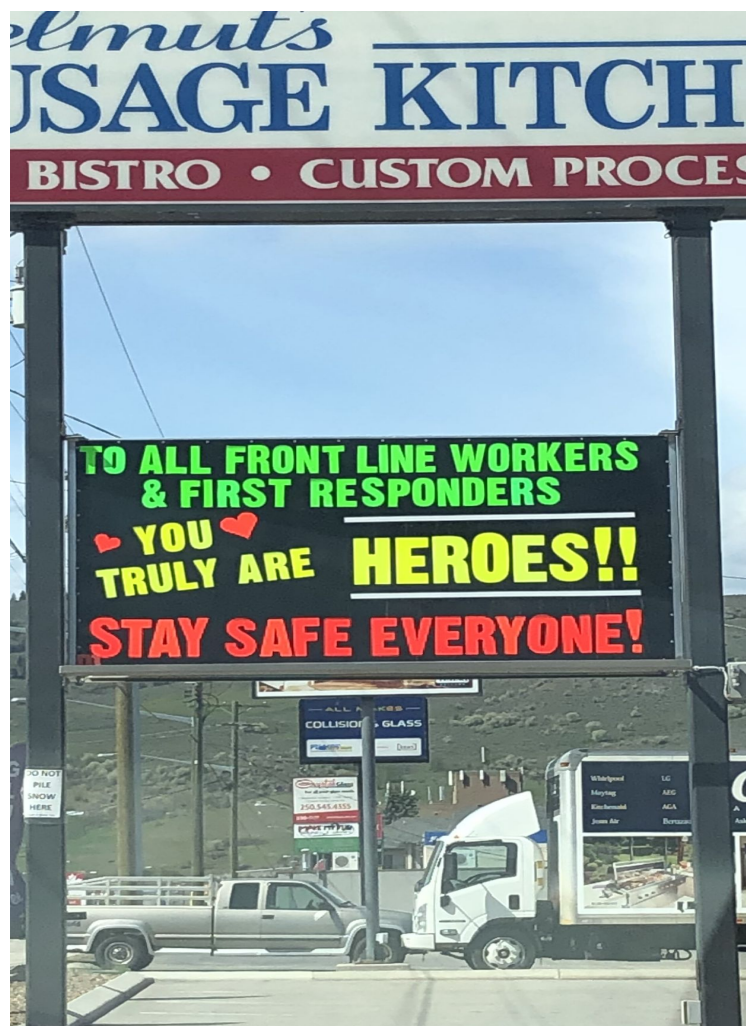
