Adapt	To change to fit a situation
Habitat	the place where a plant or animal naturally or normally lives and grows
Carnivore	an animal that eats mostly or only meat
Herbivore	a plant-eating animal
Fossil	What is left of a plant or an animal from a long time ago
Paleontologist	A scientist who studies life from long ago, often by studying fossils
Prehistoric	From times before written history, a very very long time ago
Feature	A part of something that stands, is noticeable, or is useful
Survive	To stay alive
Predator	an animal that hunts other animals for food.
Evidence	something that gives proof or a reason to believe something
Digest	What your body does to your food after you eat it. The process of breaking food down, and turning it into energy.
Climate	The usual weather in a place.
